
THIS COURT ORDERS that:

The 'treating physician', pursuant to Section 2.5(ii)(b) of Exhibit D of the *Dow Corning/British Columbia and Other Provinces Breast Implant Litigation Settlement Agreement*, includes the Licensed Medical Specialist (LMS) (as defined in section 2.5(ii)(a) of Exhibit D of the Settlement Agreement) who made the diagnosis of the Eligible Claimant's Designated Medical Condition if that LMS states that (s)he has the information necessary to form a professional opinion about the Eligible Claimant's disability and sets forth in the statement or diagnosis (or a supplemental statement) the information upon which that opinion is based and the source of that information.
